Call to Order at 5:00 p.m.

Treasurer Report: No report for this month's budget remains at \$7,500. for 2023

Old Business: a. Flower Baskets-order was not placed by Kendra.

Discussion: Frank asked if the committee would hold off on ordering the baskets until he checks the unit's attachments for the lamp poles. The attachments that come with the units may not be the correct ones.

Questions followed as to how many basket units should be ordered, how to navigate watering and which streets to hang them. It was decided to order 15 units, alternating the lamp posts with flower baskets and flags. Baskets will be hung along Vineyard and Main.

Frank wants to recheck the lamp posts to confirm the type of basket attachment needed before placing the order. Frank and Darlene will set up a date to meet to finalize order.

b. Banners-spring/summer banners need to be ordered. Committee will look at catalog.

c. 9W Banners-Dave Plavchak, Town Supervisor will take over the lead on this project. The banners previously ordered are too small for 9W and will be used in the hamlet. The 9W banners will be larger and have the Town of Lloyd logo on them.

d. Welcome to Highland Sign Landscaping project-discussion centered around curb appeal ideas, sign refresh, how to announce the project to the public, creating a letter of interest to send out to landscapers, presentation to the Town Board. Craig will draft a document/contract of adoption for landscapers, speak to Dave Plavchak about issues that may arise, and set up a date to present to the Town Board.

New Business:

- a. Town of Lloyd Events Committee-Classic Clover 5K Run- would like us to make sure flags are hung in the hamlet for their event.

- b. Milton Ave-Veteran's Flags- discussion as to placing all the veteran flags along Milton Ave, where Veteran's Park is located. The idea of naming it "Veteran's Way" was brought by the Supervisor, Dave Plavchak (who joined the meeting later on), Frank Alfonso and committee. Dave Plavchak will speak to Lenny about the idea.
