MINUTES, May 18, 2026

Chairperson Neil Curri called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Minutes from April not yet available.

Reports:

Greenhouse Gas Inventory - Vassar intern Korian McLane gave her presentation on community greenhouse gas emissions. Wastewater and the water district produced the highest emissions. Some of the biggest costs included fuel for the vehicle fleet. Ideas for emissions reductions include vehicles and outdoor lighting. Wastewater treatment reduction would include a huge amount of capital investment. Korian will give the same presentation to the town board on May 20.

Grants – No change from last month. Curri and Malarcher will attend training for Chodikee Lake water quality monitoring next week. The goal will be sampling twice a month in June, July and August.

Cleanup and Waterchestnut pulls – Tentative date for the Black Creek cleanup will be June 7 at 10:00. Oggenfuss will make a flyer for facebook town and paddling pages. Tentative date of June 27 for water chestnut pulls with another one to be planned for the beginning of July.

Springfest and Lloyd Leaf – Lloyd Leaf was distributed at Springfest. Many town members were engaged and talked with us and left contact info. The compost initiative was a learning experience. The bins were not color differentiated or signed. ECC members helped people add food waste to the correct bin at times. Next year we will need much bigger signs and we could ask DJ to make an announcement several times during the day (Oggenfuss knows the DJ and will ask next year).

Oggenfuss/Savino moved/seconded that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.
