**Local Law of the year 2025
Town of Lloyd, County of Ulster**

A local law to override the tax levy limit established in General Municipal Law § 3-c

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to override the limit on the amount of real property taxes that maybe levied by the Town of Lloyd pursuant to General Municipal Law § 3-c, and to allow the Town of Lloyd to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2020 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the “tax levy limit” as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law § 3-c, which expressly authorizes the town board to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a local law approved by vote of sixty percent (60%) of the town board.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override

The Town Board of the Town of Lloyd, County of Ulster is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2025 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise proscribed in General Municipal Law, §3-c.

Section 4. Severability

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

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Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

- J. RESOLUTION** to assign the costs of the emergency repair of the water line at 135 Grand Street (SBL# 88.69-4-15) to the 2026 Town of Lloyd Property tax bill.
